Etodolac5.0% w/w
Camphor4.0% w/w
Linseed Oil3.0% w/w
Methyl Salicylate5.0% w/w
Menthol10.0% w/w

Read this Patient Information before you start using this Cream and each time you get a refill. This information does not replace talking with your healthcare provider about your medical condition or treatment.

What is this Cream?

This Cream is a topical medication used for the relief of:

- Musculoskeletal pain (muscle pain, joint pain, stiffness)
- Inflammation and pain relief associated with conditions like arthritis, sprains, and strains
- Relieving discomfort caused by minor injuries or overuse of muscles

This Cream is not for:

- Internal use (it is for external application only).
- Treating conditions other than those mentioned unless directed by a healthcare provider.

Who should not use this Cream?

Do not use this Cream if you:

- Are allergic to S(+))Etodolac, camphor, menthol, methyl salicylate, linseed oil, or any other ingredient in the cream (see the end of this leaflet for the complete list of ingredients).
- Have a history of asthma, urticaria (hives), or other allergic reactions to NSAIDs or other topical medications.
- Have open wounds, broken, or damaged skin in the area of application.
- Are pregnant, particularly in the third trimester.
- Are under the age of 12 years unless directed by a healthcare provider.

What should I tell my healthcare provider before using this Cream?

Before using this Cream, tell your healthcare provider if you:

- Have a history of liver or kidney problems.
- Have any skin conditions, sensitivities, or allergic reactions to topical treatments.
- Are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if this medicine can harm your unborn baby.
- Are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. It is not known if the ingredients in this medicine pass into breast milk.
- Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

How should I use this Cream?

Use this Cream exactly as your healthcare provider tells you.

- Apply a thin layer of cream to the affected area.
- Gently massage the cream into the skin until fully absorbed.
- Apply 1-3 times a day or as directed by your healthcare provider.
- Wash your hands thoroughly after application unless your hands are the treatment site.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, or mucous membranes. If contact occurs, rinse thoroughly with water.
- Do not cover the treated area with a bandage or heating pad unless instructed by your healthcare provider.

What are the possible side effects of this Cream?

Common side effects include:

- Mild skin irritation at the site of application (redness, itching, or burning).
- Dryness, peeling, or flaking of the skin.

Rare but serious side effects include:

- Severe allergic reactions, such as rash, swelling, or difficulty breathing.
- Severe irritation or discoloration at the application site.
- Tell your healthcare provider if you experience any side effects that bother you or do not go away.

How should I store this Cream?

- Store this Cream at room temperature, between 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F).
- Keep the tube tightly closed when not in use.
- Keep the Cream and all medicines out of the reach of children.

General information about the safe and effective use of this Cream

- Do not use this Cream for a condition for which it was not prescribed.
- Do not share this medication with other people, even if they have the same symptoms.
- You can ask your pharmacist or healthcare provider for information that is written for health professionals.

What are the ingredients in this Gel?

Active ingredients:

- S(+)-Etorolac: A nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) that helps reduce pain and inflammation.
- Camphor: A cooling agent that helps soothe pain and discomfort.
- Linseed Oil: Known for its soothing properties, it helps in moisturizing the skin and supporting healing.
- Menthol: Provides a cooling sensation, which helps relieve pain and reduce muscle spasms.
- Methyl Salicylate: A compound that helps relieve pain and inflammation by acting as a mild topical analgesic.

Inactive Ingredient's:

- Cream base`
