(Luliconazole 1% w/w) **Anti-Fungal Cream**

### Active Ingredients:

Luliconazole ..... 1.0% w/w

Read this Patient Information before you start using this Luliconazole Cream and each time you get a refill. This information does not replace talking with your healthcare provider about your medical condition or treatment.

### What is this Luliconazole Cream?

This Luliconazole Cream is a prescription antifungal medication used for the treatment of:

- Tinea pedis (athlete's foot)
- Tinea cruris (jock itch)
- Tinea corporis (ringworm)
- Tinea versicolor (a fungal skin infection)
- This cream works by killing the fungi that cause infections on the skin.

### This Luliconazole Cream is not for:

- Internal use (it is only for external application).
- Treating conditions other than those mentioned unless directed by a healthcare provider.

### Who should not use this Luliconazole Cream?

#### Do not use this Luliconazole Cream if you:

- Are allergic to luliconazole or any of the ingredients in the cream. (See the end of this leaflet for a complete list of ingredients).
- Have a skin infection that is not fungal in nature.

### What should I tell my healthcare provider before using this Luliconazole Cream?

#### Before using this Luliconazole Cream, tell your healthcare provider if you:

- Have any skin conditions or sensitivities.
- Are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if this medicine can harm your unborn baby.
- Are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. It is not known if the ingredients in this medicine pass into breast milk.
- Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

**How should I use Luliconazole Cream?**

Use Luliconazole Cream exactly as your healthcare provider tells you.

- Apply a thin layer of cream to the affected area once daily.
- Gently rub it in until fully absorbed.
- Wash your hands thoroughly after application unless your hands are the treatment site.
- Continue using the cream for the full prescribed duration, even if symptoms improve, to ensure the infection is completely treated.
- Do not apply the cream more than once a day unless directed by your healthcare provider.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, or mucous membranes. If contact occurs, rinse thoroughly with water.

**What are the possible side effects of Luliconazole Cream?****Common side effects include:**

- Mild skin irritation, redness, or itching at the site of application
- Dryness or peeling of the treated skin

**Rare but serious side effects include:**

- Severe allergic reactions, such as rash, swelling, or difficulty breathing
- Skin burning or discoloration at the application site
- Tell your healthcare provider if you experience any side effects that bother you or do not go away.

**How should I store this Luliconazole Cream?**

- Store this Luliconazole Cream at room temperature, between 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F).
- Keep the tube tightly closed when not in use.
- Keep Luliconazole Cream and all medicines out of the reach of children.

**General information about the safe and effective use of this Luliconazole Cream**

- Do not use this Luliconazole Cream for a condition for which it was not prescribed.
- Do not share this medication with other people, even if they have the same symptoms.
- You can ask your pharmacist or healthcare provider for information that is written for health professionals.

**What are the ingredients in this Medicated Gel?****Active ingredients:**

- Luliconazole: An antifungal agent that works by inhibiting the growth of fungi that cause infections.

**Inactive Ingredients:**

- Cream base
