Active Ingredients:

Mupirocin Ointment2% w/w

Read this Patient Information before you start using Mupirocin Ointment and each time you get a refill. This information does not take the place of talking with your healthcare provider about your medical condition or treatment.

What is Mupirocin Ointment used for?

Mupirocin Ointment is a prescription medicine used to treat:

- Bacterial skin infections, such as impetigo and secondary infections caused by susceptible organisms.
- Nasal carriage of *Staphylococcus aureus* (when prescribed for intranasal use).

Who can use Mupirocin Ointment?

Mupirocin Ointment is suitable for:

- Adults and children aged 3 months and older for bacterial skin infections.
- Infants under 3 months only under close supervision and as prescribed by a healthcare provider.

Who should not use this Gel?

Do not use this if you:

- If you are allergic to mupirocin or any of the ingredients in the ointment.
- On large areas of damaged or broken skin.
- For viral or fungal skin infections (e.g., herpes or athlete's foot).
- Inside the eyes, mouth, or deep wounds.

What should I tell my healthcare provider before using Mupirocin Ointment?

Before using Mupirocin Ointment, tell your healthcare provider if you:

- Have or suspect a skin infection not caused by bacteria.
- Have any history of allergies to topical antibiotics.
- Are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding.

How should I use Mupirocin Ointment?

Use Mupirocin Ointment exactly as your healthcare provider tells you.

- Apply a small amount of the ointment to the affected area 2-3 times daily.
- Gently cover the area with a bandage or dressing if directed.
- Do not use for more than 10 days unless prescribed.
- Wash your hands before and after applying the ointment unless your hands are the treatment site.

What are the possible side effects of Mupirocin Ointment?

Common side effects include:

- Localized irritation, burning, or itching at the application site.

Rare but serious side effects include:

- Severe allergic reactions, such as rash, hives, or swelling.
- Signs of a new or worsening infection.
- Stop using the ointment and consult your healthcare provider if you experience any unusual or severe side effects. Bother you or do not go away.

How should I store Mupirocin Ointment?

- Store Mupirocin Ointment at room temperature, between 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F).
- Keep the tube tightly closed when not in use.
- Keep this ointment and all medicines out of the reach of children.
