Triamcinolone Acetonide.....0.1% w/w

What is this Cream used for?

Triamcinolone Acetonide Cream is a medium-strength corticosteroid used for:

- Relieving inflammation, redness, itching, and swelling caused by:
- Eczema, Psoriasis, Dermatitis
- Allergic skin reactions
- Treating inflammatory skin disorders responsive to corticosteroids

Who should not use this Cream?

Do not use this cream if you:

- Are allergic to Triamcinolone Acetonide or any of the cream's ingredients
- Have a viral, bacterial, or fungal skin infection unless being treated concurrently
- Have tuberculosis of the skin or rosacea
- Are applying it to broken skin, open wounds, or ulcers, unless prescribed
- Are pregnant or breastfeeding, unless advised by a healthcare provider

Who can use this Cream?

- Adults and Elderly Patients: Safe when used as directed by a healthcare provider
- Children above 12 years: Use with caution under adult supervision
- Children under 12 years: Use only if prescribed by a healthcare provider

What should I tell my healthcare provider before using this Cream?

Inform your doctor if you:

- Have any skin infections or other dermatological conditions
- Are using other topical corticosteroids
- Are pregnant, planning pregnancy, or breastfeeding
- Have diabetes, immune system disorders, or skin thinning

How should I use this Cream?

For Adults and Children Over 12 Years:

- Clean and dry the affected area before application
- Apply a thin layer to the affected area 2-3 times daily, or as directed by your healthcare provider
- Gently rub in until absorbed
- Do not apply to face, groin, or underarms unless prescribed
- Avoid bandaging or covering the treated area unless instructed

For Children Under 12 Years:

- Use only under medical supervision
- Possible Side Effects of this Cream

Common Side Effects:

- Burning, itching, dryness, or redness at the site of application
- Skin thinning or stretch marks with long-term use
- Changes in skin color

Rare but Serious Side Effects:

- Hormonal imbalance (especially with prolonged or excessive use)

- Suppression of adrenal gland function
- Increased risk of skin infections
- If side effects persist or worsen, stop use and contact your healthcare provider

How should I store this Cream?

- Store at room temperature, 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F)
- Protect from light and moisture
- Keep out of reach of children

General Information about Safe Use

- For external use only
- Do not use for long periods or on large surface areas unless prescribed
- Avoid contact with eyes, nose, mouth, and broken skin
- Do not share this medication with others
- Use only for the condition prescribed

What are the ingredients in this Cream?**Active Ingredients:**

- **Triamcinolone Acetonide** – A synthetic corticosteroid that reduces inflammation, itching, and allergic reactions in the skin

Inactive Ingredients:

- Cream base
