(Clotrimazole 2% w/w & Clindamycin Phosphate 2% w/w Vaginal Cream)

Active Ingredients:

Clotrimazole 2.0% w/w

Clindamycin Phosphate 2.0% w/w

Read this information before using the vaginal cream and each time you get a refill. This leaflet is not a substitute for medical advice from your healthcare provider.

What is this Vaginal Cream used for?

This cream is a dual-action vaginal medication used to treat:

- Mixed vaginal infections, particularly where both fungal (Candida) and bacterial (Bacterial Vaginosis) pathogens are present
- Vaginal itching, discharge, or discomfort caused by these infections
- It combines an antifungal (Clotrimazole) with an antibiotic (Clindamycin) for broad-spectrum action.

Who should NOT use this Vaginal Cream?

Do not use this cream if you:

- Are allergic to clotrimazole, clindamycin, lincomycin, or any component of the cream
- Have a history of antibiotic-associated colitis or diarrhea
- Are currently using latex condoms or diaphragms for contraception (oil base may weaken latex)

Who can use this Vaginal Cream?

- Adult women and adolescents (over 12 years) as prescribed
- Pregnant women: Use only under medical supervision
- Breastfeeding: Caution advised; consult your doctor

Tell your healthcare provider if you:

- Are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding
- Have a history of vaginal yeast infections
- Recently used other antibiotic or antifungal vaginal treatments
- Have any stomach or intestinal conditions, especially colitis
- Are using any oral or topical medications, vitamins, or herbal products

How should I use this Vaginal Cream?

Use exactly as prescribed. Usually:

- Insert the cream once daily at bedtime, using the applicator provided
- Clean hands before and after use
- Use for 3 to 7 days, as directed by your doctor
- Avoid sexual intercourse during treatment
- Do not use tampons, douches, or other vaginal products while using this cream

Possible Side Effects

Common side effects:

- Vaginal burning or irritation
- Abdominal cramps or mild diarrhea
- Itching or discharge

Rare but serious side effects:

- Allergic reactions (rash, itching, swelling, dizziness, breathing difficulty)
- Severe diarrhea that may occur even weeks after stopping treatment (pseudomembranous colitis)
- Discontinue use and consult your healthcare provider if symptoms persist or worsen.

How should I store this Cream?

- Storage Instructions
- Store at room temperature, 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F)
- Do not freeze
- Keep the tube tightly closed
- Keep out of reach of children

General Usage Tips:

- Complete the full course even if symptoms improve early
- Avoid using during menstruation unless directed
- Avoid alcohol-based vaginal products
- Use non-latex condoms or other contraceptive methods during treatment and for 5 days afterward

What are the ingredients in this Vaginal Cream?**Active Ingredients:**

- **Clotrimazole** – Antifungal agent (inhibits fungal cell membrane synthesis)
- **Clindamycin Phosphate** – Lincosamide antibiotic (inhibits bacterial protein synthesis)

Inactive Ingredients:

- Cream base
