(Clobetasol Propionate 0.05% w/w, Gentamicin Sulphate 0.1% w/w, Tolnaftate 1% w/w, Iodochlorhydroxyquinoline 1% w/w, Clotrimazole 1% w/w) Medicated **Cream**

### Active Ingredients:

Clobetasol Propionate ..... 0.05% w/w  
Gentamicin Sulphate ..... 0.1% w/w  
Tolnaftate ..... 1.0% w/w  
Iodochlorhydroxyquinoline ..... 1.0% w/w  
Clotrimazole ..... 1.0% w/w

### What is this Cream used for?

This is a multi-action topical cream used for treating a wide range of mixed skin infections. It offers:

- Anti-inflammatory effect to reduce redness and itching (Clobetasol)
- Broad-spectrum antibacterial action (Gentamicin, Iodochlorhydroxyquinoline)
- Antifungal action (Clotrimazole, Tolnaftate)
- Treatment of bacterial, fungal, and mixed dermal infections
- Relief in conditions like dermatitis, eczema with superinfection, tinea, intertrigo, and infected fungal skin lesions

### Who should not use this Cream?

Avoid use if you:

- Are allergic to any of the ingredients
- Have viral skin infections like chickenpox or herpes
- Are pregnant or breastfeeding, unless advised by a healthcare provider
- Intend to use it on broken skin, open wounds, or mucous membranes (e.g., eyes, mouth, genitals)

### Who can use this Cream?

Adults and Children 12 years & older:

- Safe to use as prescribed
- Apply in thin layers, only on affected skin

Children under 12 years:

- Use only if prescribed by a doctor
- Avoid long-term or large-area application due to risk of systemic absorption

### What should I tell my healthcare provider before using this Cream?

Inform your doctor if you:

- Have any known allergies
- Have a history of skin thinning or hormone sensitivity
- Are taking any other topical or oral medicines
- Are pregnant, planning pregnancy, or breastfeeding

### How should I use this Cream?

- Clean and dry the affected area
- Apply a thin layer 1–2 times daily or as advised
- Do not bandage unless instructed
- Wash hands after application (unless treating hands)
- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, and mucous membranes

### Possible Side Effects

#### Common:

- Mild burning, stinging, redness
- Dryness or peeling of the skin

#### Rare but Serious:

- Allergic reaction (rash, swelling, breathing difficulty)
- Hormonal effects with long-term use (weight gain, fatigue)
- Skin thinning or discoloration

### How should I store this Cream?

- Storage Instructions
- Store at 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F)
- Do not freeze
- Keep away from children
- General Precautions
- Use only for the condition prescribed
- Do not share this cream
- Discontinue if irritation worsens and consult a doctor
- Avoid prolonged use beyond 2 weeks unless directed

### What are the ingredients in this Cream?

#### Active Ingredients:

- **Clobetasol Propionate** – Corticosteroid (anti-inflammatory)
- **Gentamicin Sulphate** – Antibiotic (bacterial infections)
- **Tolnaftate** – Antifungal (dermatophytes, tinea)
- **Iodochlorhydroxyquinoline** – Antibacterial/Antifungal
- **Clotrimazole** – Broad-spectrum antifungal

#### Inactive Ingredients:

- Cream base, Emulsifiers, Preservative
